Drop in after school for fun with books, games, and crafts.

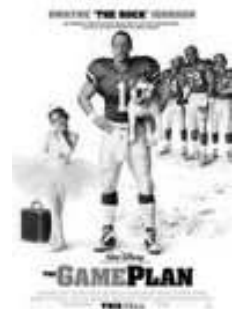

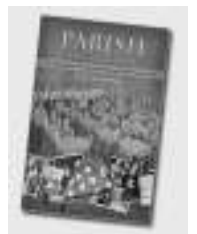
