FREE PASS TO OAK LAWN MUSEUM

Adult library card holders of the Prairie trails Public Library District may check-out a pass to the CHILDREN'S MUSEUM in Oak Lawn (9600 E. Shore Drive). The pass will allow four people (children and/or adults) free admission.
The library rules for the pass will be the same as those for the Brookfield Zoo passes we circulate, which are:
Only residents of our library district may check out the pass.
The adult patron's library card must be free of fines and/or bills.
The passes are good for 3 days.
No renewals and no reserves will be accepted.
The card **MUST BE HANDED** to a circulation clerk at the desk when being returned (Because of the size of the pass we don't want it falling in the crack of the book drop.)
Fines: \$1 if the pass is found in the book drop, \$2 per day until returned.
If lost there will be a \$50 replacement cost.
When a patron is checking out the Children's Museum pass, they must sign on "rules information" sheet.

Introduction to Wireless

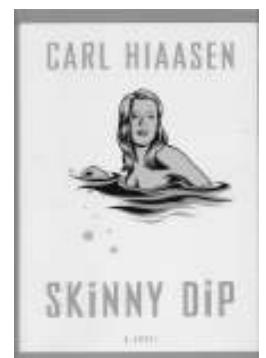

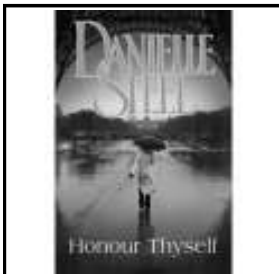
An introduction to wireless access at the library and what you need to know to use wi-fi at home.
