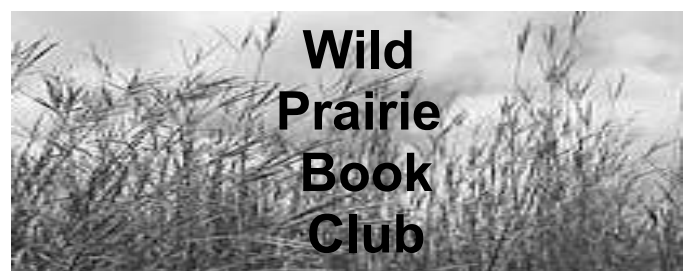
AUTHOR VISIT
