J/ADL	<i>Cam Jansen mysteries</i> (series) by David Adler (60p).
J/ADV	<i>Mary-Kate and Ashley adventures/mysteries</i> by various authors.
J/AME	<i>Betrayal at Cross Creek</i> (& other American Girl mysteries) by Kathleen Ernst. Twelve-year-old Elspeth, a Scottish settler and weaver's apprentice on the North Carolina frontier in 1775, must find out who is betraying her Loyalist family during the months before the start of the Revolutionary War (163p).
J/AME	<i>The Silent Stranger: a Kaya Mystery</i> by Janet B. Shaw. In 1765, the arrival of an injured stranger from another tribe, traveling alone and apparently unable to speak, arouses suspicion in Kaya's Nez Percé village (132p).
J/AME	<i>A Spy on the Home Front: a Molly Mystery</i> by Alison Hart. During a visit to her grandparents' Illinois farm in 1944, ten-year-old Molly tries to prove the innocence of a German-American neighbor whom the FBI suspects of smuggling anti-American propaganda (165p).
J/CHE	<i>The Playmaker</i> by J.B. Cheaney. While working as an apprentice in a London theater company in 1597, fourteen-year-old Richard uncovers a mystery involving the disappearance of his father and a traitorous plot to overthrow Queen Elizabeth (307p).
J/COL	<i>Escape Key</i> by Michael Coleman (114p).
J/DAD	<i>The Bailey School Kids mysteries</i> (series) by Debbie Dadey (80p).
J/DEF	<i>The Ghost of Cutler Creek</i> by Cynthia De Felice. When Allie is contacted by the ghost of a dog, she and Dub investigate the surly new boy at school and his father, who may be running a puppy mill, to see if they are involved (181p).
J/DIX	<i>The Hardy Boys mysteries</i> (series) by Franklin Dixon (150-200p).
J/HAD	<i>The House on the Gulf</i> by Margaret P. Haddix. A sixteen-year-old boy arranges a housesitting job for the summer, but he starts acting strangely after his family moves in, and his sister begins to suspect they are not supposed to be there (201p).
J/HAL	<i>Murder, My Tweet: From the Tattered Casebook of Chet Gecko, Private Eye</i> by Bruce Hale. Detective Chet Gecko and his associate, Natalie Attired, take a case tailing what they think is a cheating boyfriend but are instead led to a school mystery that involves blackmail and robots (117p).
J/HOO	<i>The Ghost in the Tokaido Inn</i> by Dorothy Hoobler. While attempting to solve the mystery of a stolen jewel, Seikei, a merchant's son who longs to be a samurai, joins a group of kabuki actors in eighteenth-century Japan (214p).
J/KEE	<i>Nancy Drew mysteries</i> (series) by Carolyn Keene.
J/LEP	<i>Mandie mysteries</i> (series) by Lois Gladys Leppard (150+p).
J/LIZ	<i>Lizzie McGuire mysteries</i> by Lisa Banim (125-130p).

- J/MAR *Dawn and the Surfer Ghost* (& other Baby-Sitter's Club mysteries) by Ann M. Martin (145p).
- J/MIC *Mystery of the Garbage Gang* (a Mickey Mouse mystery). Mickey and Minnie turn into crime-fighting detectives as they set out to uncover the truth about the polluters and the crooked cops in their neighborhood (89p).
- J/NAP *Sly the Sleuth and the Pet Mysteries* by Donna Jo Napoli. Sly the Sleuth, also known as Sylvia, solves three mysteries for her friends and neighbors, all involving pets, through her detective agency, Sleuth for Hire (92p).
- J/NIX *The Internet Escapade* by Joan Lowry Nixon. Sean and Matt were playing harmless pranks on the school computer, but now someone is up to real mischief and Sean is getting all the blame. When Sean starts getting threatening messages at home, it's time for the Casebusters to jump into action (86p).
- J/ROY *A to Z mysteries* (series) by Ron Roy. A mystery for each letter of the alphabet (85p).
- J/SCO *Scooby-Doo mysteries* by James Gelsey (60p).
- J/SKU *The Hunted* by Gloria Skurzynski. The Landon family travels to Glacier National Park to investigate why grizzly bear cubs are disappearing and becomes involved with a ten-year-old Mexican runaway boy (147p).
- J/SMI *Cryptid Hunters* by Roland Smith. Twins, Grace and Marty, along with a mysterious uncle, are dropped into the middle of the Congolese jungle in search of their missing photojournalist parents (348p).
- J/SOB *Encyclopedia Brown mysteries* by Donald J. Sobol (70-100p).
- J/STI *Geronimo Stilton mysteries* (series) by Geronimo Stilton (120p).
